Universal Infants Free School Meals (UIFSM)

All Infant children are entitled to a Universal Infant Free School Meal.

Have you registered?

All Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 could get a <u>free</u> school lunch (this is not the same scheme as Universal Infant Free School Meals.)

By registering for a <u>free</u> school lunch our school could get additional funding called **Pupil Premium**, which could help towards extra support for your child, computers, books, trips out and staffing etc.

Your child could get a free school meal if you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- > The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (as long as you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and you don't get more than £16,190 a year)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit.

Did you know?

- Registering for a FSM helps schools identify anyone on a low income; the school can then claim additional funding from the government, which can help towards extra computers, books, trips out and staff etc.
- If your child is eligible for *free* school meals, they'll remain eligible until March 2023, or until they finish their current phase of schooling (primary or secondary), if that's after March 2023.
