Uniform Policy

January 2023

We want children to be proud of our school and to wear the correct uniform. The uniform is simple, but smart. It helps the children to identify with each other and with our local community.

A range of pre-loved uniform is available to all in school. Before buying new uniform, do consider using this option. Please contact Mary Bull, our Family Support Worker, for more information (MaryB@lodgefarm.herts.sch.uk). Donations for this are also warmly welcomed.

All uniform should be clearly named

All children are to wear:

- White collared shirt or polo shirt
- Grey trousers, tailored knee-length shorts, skirt or pinafore dress (a blue and white checked dress is optional in the summer)
- Navy blue long sleeved jumper/sweatshirt/fleece/cardigan (no hoodies or logos with the exception of the school logo)
- Headwear should be in line with school colours
- Sensible black shoes/sandals/trainers
- Wellingtons can be worn in inclement weather but a change of shoes should be provided
- Nursery and Reception children need to have a pair of wellingtons and a waterproof for outdoor play
- Stud earrings only – removed or covered for PE days
- No make-up, including nail varnish
- If hair is long enough, it should be tied back fully
- Watches and step counters may be worn, but these should not have text or recording features

PE kit

All children are to wear:

- Blue PE t-shirt
- Navy shorts
- Navy joggers and navy sweatshirt in winter without logos unless it is the school logo
- Trainers
- No jewellery – stud earrings must be covered on PE days

If children are not wearing correct uniform a phone call to parents will be made to ensure that this is corrected and any support needed with this will be put in place.
