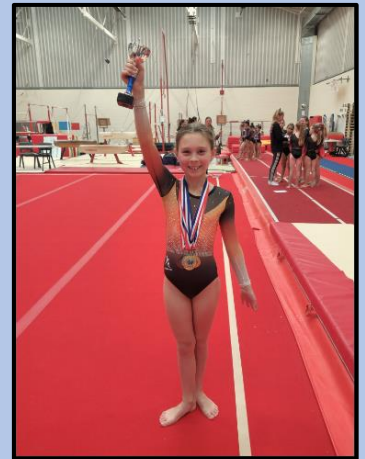
Children's Achievements
