Our Lollipop Lady, Michelle, has been nominated for the 999 Hero Award for performing life-saving CPR.

Michelle saw someone in difficulty in their car and ran to help the driver, who had suffered a cardiac arrest. Michelle had received First Aid training as part of her role as Crossing Patrol Warden and so started CPR on the lady. Michelle restarted the flow of oxygen to her brain, therefore saving her life.
