Year 2 Trip - Lee Valley

On **Tuesday 18th April 2023**, Year 2 will be going on their school trip to Lee Valley (Myddelton House Gardens) on a plant discovery day! This trip will enhance the children's knowledge about plants which links to our science topic for this term.

Cost and timings

The cost of the trip is £18.20 per child. This includes the cost of the day and the coach. Payments can be made via Gateway. Whilst the school has subsidised part of this trip, we regret that we cannot fund the entire experience. Therefore, we must inform you that if we do not receive enough money to pay for the trip, it will not be able to go ahead.

If we can please ask that payment is made by Friday 31st March 2023 this will give us enough time to pay Lee Valley in advance before the Easter holidays. Thank you for every payment that is made.

We will be leaving Lodge Farm at **9.15am** and leaving Lee Valley Park to return at **2.15pm**. We should be back in time for normal dismissal times. Any change of these timings you will be informed via text on the day. Please also give your consent for the trip via Gateway.

Clothing
